JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to resume her pension under Employees Pension Scheme.

2. The respondent on account of non-filing of Digital Life Certificate withheld pension of the petitioner which compelled her to approach this Court. During the pendency of instant petition, the respondent has released arrears as well as restarted monthly pension.

3. Mr. Rajesh Hooda, Advocate submits that system does not release pension, if an employee fails to file Digital Life Certificate which is required to be filed annually. The petitioner undertakes that in future, she will file her Digital Life Certificate as required by respondents.



4. The grievance of the petitioner, at this stage, stands redressed, thus, petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to release arrears, if any, outstanding as on date.

5. Pending misc. application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
