1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of certiorari for quashing the disciplinary proceedings initiated by way of charge-sheet dated 06.06.2022 (Annexure P-32) issued to the petitioner by respondent No.1.

2. Learned counsel for respondents No.1 to 3 submits that the instant petition has been rendered infructuous as the petitioner has challenged the charge-sheet dated 06.06.2022 (Annexure P-32) in the present writ petition and whereas subsequently, the said charge-sheet has been culminated into passing of punishment order of recovery of Rs.1,47,09,275/- and stoppage of two increments vide order dated

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18.05.2023 and his appeal dated 24.05.2023 filed against the punishment order has also been dismissed vide orders dated 13.07.2023/28.07.2023, which have been challenged by the petitioner in CWP No.18416 of 2023, in which notice of motion has been issued and the same is still pending consideration before this Court.

3. In view of the above, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of accordingly.
