Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that all the candidates, who are likely to be affected by the outcome of the present petition, could not be impleaded, hence the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh one on the same cause of action by impleading all the candidates, who are likely to be affected by the outcome of the prayer to be made in the fresh petition.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not have the data/information of the selected candidates and in case, any application is made by the petitioner, the respondents be

directed to release the details of the selected candidates so that they could be impleaded while filing the fresh petition.

Learned counsel for the respondent-Commission submits that in case, any application is moved by the petitioner seeking the details of the selected/recommended candidates, the same will be supplied within a period of seven days of receiving any such application.

Petition is disposed of as not pressed with liberty as prayed for.
