As per the affidavit dated 14.7.2016 filed by the Special Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, Home Department, they have placed on record a report dated 1.3.2016 (Annexure R-1/10) from the Deputy Commissioner, Hisar and as per this report, some families continued to stay in the village and some had left the village Mirchpur but they have come back and they are staying there and they are safe. Some of the families have chosen themselves to live outside village Mirchpur as the persons staying in village Mirchpur are not facing any threat.

2. At this stage, learned counsel for petitioners has been unable to controvert the report Annexure R-1/10. Since the petitioners who have chosen to move away from village Mirchpur, cannot be compelled to come back to the same village.

3. In view of the above position, the present writ petition is being disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to approach the competent authority in case they face any difficulty.

4. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
