HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the benefit of the notification dated 05.02.2004 has not been given to the petitioner so as to revise his pay, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner after retirement as his pensionary benefits have also not been fixed in accordance with law.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents, on the instructions from Mr. Jatinder Pal Singh, Senior Assistant, O/o Divisional Soil Conservation, Ludhiana, submits that the benefit of the notification dated 05.02.2004 has already been implemented qua the petitioner and the benefits have already been granted to the petitioner.

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3. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the similar claim was also raised in ***CWP No.18400 of 1998 titled as Ashok Kumar and others vs. State of Punjab and others, decided on 07.02.2023*** wherein also, a similar statement was made and the petitions have been disposed of.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that the pensionary benefits of the petitioner have not been revised even after deciding to grant the petitioner the benefit of the notification dated 05.02.2004, they will pass an appropriate order giving the details as to how the benefit extended to the petitioner has been implemented in terms of the increase in pay as well as pensionary benefits.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the benefit being claimed by the petitioner has already been extended in favour of one Sh. Surinder Kumar Kansal, Sub Divisional Officer, Sh. Gurej Singh, Sub Divisional Soil Conservative Officer, Sh. Charanjit Singh, Soil Conservative Officer and Sh. Mohinder Singh, Jr. Engineer and the respondents be directed to decide the claim of the petitioner in light of the benefit given to the other person.

6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that appropriate speaking order with regard to the claim of the petitioner will be passed within a period of eight weeks from today by keeping in mind the claim of the petitioner as noticed hereinbefore and in case, any benefit already allowed in favour of the petitioner has not been released, the same will be released to the petitioner and the details with regard to the released benefit if already done, will also be mentioned in the said speaking order, which



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will be conveyed to the petitioner.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

8. Ordered accordingly.
