



Adjourned to 21.08.2024.

In the meanwhile, the parties are directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate within two weeks from today or any other date convenient to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, to get recorded their statements regarding compromise and after recording their statements, learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate is directed to send report regarding the genuineness of compromise and also to intimate whether any PO proceedings are pending against any of the party on or before the date fixed i.e. 21.08.2024.

The learned Court below is directed to record the statements of petitioner Nos.1 and 4 through their special power of attorney namely Major Ram (petitioner No.2).

A copy of the order be sent to learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate through fax for compliance.'

3. In compliance of the above order, a report has been received from the concerned jurisdictional Court that the compromise between the parties is genuine and arrived at without any pressure or coercion from anyone.

4. In view of the compromise and the ratio of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466, Ramgopal and another Vs. State of Madhya Pradesh 2021 SCC OnLine SC 834 and Shakuntala Sawhney (Mrs) Vs. Kaushalya (Mrs.) and others (1980) 1 SCC 63** and Full Bench of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab 2007 (3) RCR (Crl.) 1052**, this petition is allowed and FIR No.0023 dated 20.02.2017 under Section 498-A of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station City Phagwara District Kapurthala and all subsequent proceedings arising out of the same are quashed, *qua* the petitioners.
