RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 11.04.2023 passed in CWP-29189-2022.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Dr. Seema, Director, Health (ESI), Services, Punjab, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 11.04.2023 passed in CWP-29189-2022 has been complied with and the provisional pension has been released in favour of the petitioner. However, benefit of gratuity could not be released in favour of the petitioner because in absence of medical fitness certificate, he is not entitled to the same.
4. In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any more.
5. Dismissed.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
