The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.0096 dated 29.05.2023 registered under Sections 406, 420, 120B IPC at Police Station City Rupnagar, District Rupnagar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the orders dated 18.07.2023 & 07.02.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim orders dated 18.07.2023 & 07.02.2024 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and she shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
