1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to official respondents to proceed further with the investigation in fair manner in case FIR No.104 dated 15.03.2024 under Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 and Sections 148, 149, 323, 506 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Ballabgarh Sadar, Faridabad and also take action on the complaints given by the petitioner against the accused persons.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite the petitioner having approached the police for initiating action against the accused persons, the authorities concerned had been sitting over the matter. In support, he has drawn the attention of this Court to Annexures P-1 and P-4 which are complaints moved by the petitioner. It has been submitted that the official respondents were under a legal obligation to pass an appropriate order on his complaints/representations.

3. Notice of motion to official respondents only.

4. On asking of the Court, Ms. Trishanjali Sharma, DAG,



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Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

5. In the wake of the limited prayer of the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of and respondent No.2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Faridabad, is directed to look into the grievance of the petitioner and take appropriate steps, if any required, under the provisions of law. However, if respondent No.2 does not find any substance in the allegations levelled in the complaints/representations dated 19.03.2024 and 15.04.2024 (Annexures P-1 and P-4), then the petitioner shall be duly informed as per the parameters laid down by the Supreme Court in *Lalita Kumari v. Government of Uttar Pradesh & Ors. : 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979*.

6. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
