1. Challenge in the present writ petition, filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is to the proceedings under Section 10(A) of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 whereby petitioner has been put to notice regarding cancellation of the auction of *Shamlat Deh* land.
2. We have been informed that the proceedings are fixed before the Collector for tomorrow. In such circumstances, it is open to the petitioner to file response before the Collector as it is for the said authority to take action on the said notice and act in accordance with law. Thus, we are of the opinion that the present writ petition is premature and the same is disposed of, as such, with liberty to the petitioner to raise his plea before the said authority.
3. Writ petition stands disposed of.
