This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5 and to take action upon the representation dated 25.06.2024 (Annexure P3)

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondents No.4 and 5 are son and daughter-in-law of the petitioner, respectively, and were disinherited from the property in the year 2020. He also refers to the order dated 04.06.2024 passed by the trial Court restraining the said respondents from interfering into the peaceful possession. He states that despite the said order passed by the trial Court, the petitioner still being constantly harassed by respondents No.4 and 5. He submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is given to the competent authority to look into the matter and his representation dated 25.06.2024 (Annexure P3) is decided in a time bound manner.

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- 4. Mr. R.S. Thind, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State. Counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply a copy of the complete paper book to the learned State counsel, during the course of the day.
- 5. Heard.
- 6. In view of above and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and to decide the representation dated 25.06.2024 (Annexure P3) expeditiously in accordance with law and to provide necessary protection to the petitioner in case situation so warrants.
- 7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
