1. In the present writ petition, the claim of the petitioner is that the petitioner competed for the post of Clerk as advertised vide Advertisement No.2 of 2013 (Annexure P-2) but she is not being treated eligible keeping in view the fact that the educational qualification being possessed by the petitioner is from Manav Bharti University, which according to the respondents is not a valid qualification.



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2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that according to the petitioner, the said issue has already been decided by the Coordinate Bench of this Court while passing order in ***CWP No.7908 of 2017 titled as Kulwinder Kaur vs. Punjab Subordinate Service Selection Board and others, decided on 01.12.2023*** and the respondents be directed to decide the claim of the petitioner for eligibility in light of the said judgment.

3. Learned State counsel submits that the claim of the petitioner will be examined in light of the judgment in ***Kulwinder Kaur's case (supra)*** and appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order and in case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any relief, the same will be extended to the petitioner otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for her information and necessary action.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

5. Ordered accordingly.

6. Any civil miscellaneous application pending if any, also stands disposed of.
