KULDEEP TIWARI. J.(Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed seeking quashing of FIR No.0036 dated 09.03.2021, under Sections 307, 148 and 149 of IPC, and under Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Model Town Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur, on the basis of compromise deed dated 09.12.2021 (Annexure P-3).
2. A perusal of the FIR reveals that the victim has suffered three bullet injuries, at the hands of accused-petitioner, and there is nothing on record which could *prima facie* suggest that the offence under Section 307 IPC is made out, therefore, primarily, the instant case falls within one of the exceptions, as carved out by this Court in *Kulwinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Others, 2007(3)*.
3. In view of the above, this Court deems it fit and appropriate that the

instant petition cannot be allowed to be quashed, on the basis of compromise.

4. The instant petition is **dismissed** accordingly.
