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SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition by submitting that the retail outlet of petrol at the relevant place has already been commissioned and, therefore, he does not wish to press this petition.
2. It appears that the petition has been filed without any thought being put into it and the entire machinery of the High Court has been triggered

to manage the present Public Interest Litigation and, therefore, the withdrawal of petition can be permitted but by imposing costs.

3. The petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with costs of Rs.10,000/- to be deposited in favour of ‘Poor Patient Welfare Fund’, PGIMER, Chandigarh (<https://pgimer.edu.in/>).
