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HARSH BUNGER, J. (ORAL)

1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 08/10.01.2024 (Annexure P-7), passed by respondent No. 2 (Commissioner, Rohtak Division, District Rohtak, whereby orders dated 20.05.2022, 08.08.2022, 17.10.2022 and 29.11.2022 (Annexure P-2 to Annexure P-5, respectively), passed by respondent No. 3 (Assistant Collector, IInd Grade, Sampla, District Rohtak), for mode of partition, have been wrongly and illegally set aside without following the adequate process of law.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for petitioner prays for withdrawal of the instant writ petition, however, he submits that appropriate directions be issued to the concerned Assistant Collector Ist Grade to decide the partition proceedings, in pursuance to the remand order dated 08/10.01.2024 (Annexure P-7), passed by respondent No. 2, in a time bound manner.

3. Learned State counsel, in pursuance to the advance copy of petition having been served upon the State, appears and on instructions from Mr. Jitender, Naib Tehsildar, Sampla, submits that respondent No. 3, in pursuance to the remand order dated 08/10.01.2024 (Annexure P-7), passed by respondent No. 2, shall make earnest endeavour to complete the partition proceedings, within a period of six months from today, subject to any legal impediment and/or any orders passed by the higher authorities in respect of the partition proceedings.
4. In view of the aforesaid statement made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition any further.
5. Disposed of accordingly.
6. Pending application (s), if any, shall also stand closed.
