1. Petitioner (Ram Singh) has filed the instant civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, seeking directions to respondent No. 3 (Deputy Commissioner, Fatehabad) to decide his representation dated 05.05.2024 (Annexure P-7), submitted by him.
