Keeping in view the averments made in the application, which are duly supported by an affidavit, application is allowed. Order dated 13.03.2024 passed by this Court is recalled and the main writ petition is ordered to be restored to its original number and status and is taken up for hearing today itself.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner intends to approach the respondents by way of filing a representation keeping in view the fact that certain similarly situated persons have already been extended the benefit claimed in this petition and prays that the respondents be directed to decide the said representation in a time bound manner keeping in view the facts, which will be brought to notice of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, any representation is received from the petitioner, the same will be decided in accordance with law and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of said representation and in case, after the decision, it is found feasible to grant the relief to the petitioner, the same will be extended to him otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to file an appropriate representation with the authority concerned.
