AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioner Lalit Kumar Joshi has filed present petition under section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to proceed with complaint dated 22.05.2024 (P-1) against respondent Nos.4 to 7.
2. It is argued that matrimonial dispute is going on between the parties. He is receiving threats from respondent No.4 that on non-fulfillment of their demand he will be involved in false cases.
3. Notice of motion.
4. On asking of this Court, Mr. Kewal Singh, Addl. A.G. Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. He confirmed that aforesaid complaint dated 22.05.2024 (P-1) has been received and further stated that it will be considered and disposed of within 10 days.



5. In view of aforesaid factual position, respondent Nos.2 and 3 are directed to consider complaint dated 22.05.2024 (P-1) filed by petitioner and to take appropriate steps within a period of 10 days.

6. With aforesaid directions, present petition stands disposed of.
