1. Petitioner Sandeep Ohri has filed petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar to dispose of complaint bearing CRM No. 2365/2021 titled “Sandeep Ohri Vs. Surinder Kaur & others”, under Section 340 of Cr.P.C. alongwith Sections 209/181/193/120-B of IPC, in a time bound manner.

2. Learned counsel for petitioner has annexed copy of complaint (Annexure P-1) alongwith interlocutory orders (Annexure P-2), which indicates that complaint was adjourned for arguments on summoning for number of times.

3. Status report has been received from learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar which indicates that on some dates even complainant was requesting for adjournment.

4. I have considered the aforesaid facts. Complaint was filed in August 2021 and till date summoning order has not been passed. It cannot be ignored that there is a long delay in passing orders on summoning.

Therefore, learned trial Court is directed to proceed with complaint expeditiously as per law, without giving any further adjournment.

5. With aforesaid direction, petition is accordingly, disposed of.
