1. While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed:-

“By way of present petition, the petitioner is seeking quashing of FIR No.380 dated 29.10.2021 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 15(2),(4)/16 of Petroleum and Minerals Pipelines (Acquisition of Right of User in Land Act, 1962), Section 3/4 of Explosive Substance Act, 1908, Sections 379, 427, 201 IPC and Sections 3/4 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984 at Police Station Sadar, Fatehabad, Haryana (Annexure P-1) as well as all subsequent proceedings including order dated 07.06.2023 (Annexure P-2) declaring the petitioner as proclaimed person.

Inter alia submits that petitioner is ready to face trial.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Gaurav Bansal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Adjourned to 28.11.2023. However, the petitioner is granted liberty to appear before the Trial Court on or before 06.09.2023. This Court is quiet sanguine that in case the petitioner appears and applies for admission on bail, the same shall be adjudicated by the Trial Court in accordance with law expeditiously.”

2. In the preliminary submissions recorded in para 16, it has been asserted that despite the aforesaid order, the petitioner has not appeared before the trial Court.
3. In view of above, this Court does not find any reason to keep the present petition pending and the same is ordered to be dismissed.
