1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents not to interfere into the Sabha area, which is in possession of the petitioner and is being used for the benefit of general public of the village during the pendency of appeal, pending before respondent No. 1.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter alia, submits that the issue as regards bifurcation of the Sabha area as also the distribution of the property amongst the two villages is pending consideration in an appeal, which has been filed by the petitioner against the order dated 14.06.2024 (Annexure P-4) before the Divisional Commissioner, Gurugram. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the stay application filed in the aforesaid appeal is not being considered by the appellate authority.

3. Ms. Upasana Dhawan, AAG Haryana, appears in pursuance to the advance copy of the writ petition having been served upon her and on instructions from Mr. Yashpal, Reader in the office of Divisional Commissioner, Gurugram, submits that the application for stay filed alongwith the appeal shall be considered

by the appellate authority on the date already fixed before it i.e. 18.07.2024 and in any case, not more than one adjournment shall be given, which shall not be more than two weeks from that date.

4. Mr. Vikram Singh, Advocate appears and files Vakalatnama on behalf of respondent No. 4 in Court today, which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

5. In view of the aforesaid submission of learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not intend to press this petition.

6. Disposed of accordingly.

7. Pending application (s), if any, shall also stand closed.
