Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Sukhpal Singh, has, at the outset, brought to the notice of this Court that trial is nearing conclusion with only two prosecution witnesses remaining to be examined and with one witness having already been partly examined. It has also been contended by the learned State counsel that huge recovery of 13 kgs of opium, multiple times more than classified as commercial under the Act was made from the petitioner, who was nabbed on suspicion.

Learned counsel for the petitioner in view of the instructions received by the learned State counsel does not press the instant petition and prays for its withdrawal at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
