Today, at the very outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to surrender before the trial Court and to apply for grant of regular bail.

In view of the aforesaid request, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

However, in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and applies for grant of regular bail, the learned trial Court shall endeavour to dispose of the same expeditiously.

It is made clear that since another petition i.e. CRM-M-33369-2024 filed by the petitioner challenging the order vide which the petitioner has been declared a proclaimed offender, is pending adjudication before this



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Court, the Trial Court need not get swayed by the said order while deciding the regular bail application.
