HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. By this common order, three writ petitions, the details of which
have been given in the heading, are being disposed of as all the petitions
involve the same question of law on similar facts.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the claim of the petitioners is covered by the decision in ***CWP No.20580 of 2015 titled as Shamsher Singh vs. State of Haryana and others, decided on 28.08.2023*** and the present writ petitions may also be disposed of in same terms.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that though the question of law raised in the present writ petitions is covered by ***Shamsher Singh's case (supra)*** but the grant of benefit in ***Shamsher Singh's case (supra)*** is not correct.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record with their able assistance.

Once, the question of law raised in the present writ petitions is covered by ***Shamsher Singh's case (supra)***, the petitioners are also entitled for the same benefit whether, the order passed by this Court in ***Shamsher Singh's case (supra)*** is correct or not, the same can only be assailed in an LPA and not before this Court hence, the present writ petitions are also disposed of in same terms in ***Shamsher Singh's case (supra)*** .
