Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.PC. seeking quashing of order dated 23.04.2024 passed by Ld. ASJ, Jalandhar (Annexure P-3) in case FIR No.29 dated 16.02.2023 under Sections 379-B and 411 of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Division No.8, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar, Punjab (Annexure P-1) and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that earlier the petitioner was on regular bail but due to wrong date noted by the petitioner, he could not appear before the Ld. trial Court on 23.04.2024 and his absence was neither intentional nor willful. He further submits that the co-accused is already granted the concession of bail.

Petitioner absented for one day. His bail was cancelled. He is ready to surrender to face trial. Explanation given by the petitioner shows that his absence was not intentional. Order passed by the Court below is very harsh.

In the interest of justice, petitioner is directed to surrender before

the concerned Court within a period of 20 days from today and shall move an application for bail and on doing so, he shall be released on bail on furnishing of fresh bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Petition stands disposed of.
