1. Petitioners have approached this Court by way of filing present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India impugning the order dated 01.06.2023 (Annexure P-36) passed by Commissioner, Rohtak Range, Rohtak, order dated 15.04.2021 (Annexure P-12) alongwith Sanad Taksim dated 15.04.2021 (Annexure P-13), passed/issued by Assistant Collector 1st Grade, Sonipat and the impugned mutation No.2971, Annexure P-19. Further prayer has been made for staying the operation of orders (Annexures P-12 and P-13)

2. Counsel for the parties have submitted before this Court that during the pendency of the present petition, both the parties have resolved the issue by way of amicable settled and arrived at a compromise which is placed on record as Annexure P-37. They have submitted before this Court that as per compromise arrived among the parties, the partition proceedings carried out should be set aside as they have settled that the land under partition would be partitioned as per family settlement arrived at as mentioned in the compromise.

3. In view of the compromise arrived at between the parties, the present petition is disposed of. Resultantly, the impugned orders dated 01.06.2023 & 15.04.2021 along with Sanad Takseem dated 15.04.2021 and mutation No.2971, are set aside. However, it is made clear that the parties shall be bound by the compromise arrived at between the parties.
