1. Learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner submits that he is aggrieved against the order whereby displeasure was recorded by the Director General, BSF, under Rule 176-A of BSF Rules, 1969, qua him and show-cause notice has been ordered to be placed on his CR dossier.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents, while relying on the office memorandum dated 27.03.2015 issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India, specifically states that displeasure is not a penalty enlisted in Rule 11 of CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965 and, therefore, it shall not come in the way of his promotion.
3. The aforesaid satisfies the learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner.
