The instant criminal writ petition has been filed under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to the respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 5 and further directing respondent No. 2 to take action on the representation dated 29.04.2024 (Annexure P-4) sent by the petitioner to respondent No. 2.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset submits that for their grievance, the petitioner has already submitted a representation (Annexure P-4) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, but no

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action has been taken thereon so far. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case said representation is decided in a time bound manner.
