KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (ORAL)

1. Through the instant petition, as instituted under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C., the petitioner, who has been arrayed as an accused in a couple of more cases registered under the N.D.P.S. Act, seeks the concession of anticipatory bail, in case FIR No.50 dated 03.06.2024, under Sections 21/27/29/61/85 of the N.D.P.S. Act, 1985, registered at P.S. Ghagga, District Patiala.

2. After addressing arguments at length, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, since the allegedly recovered contraband in the present case falls within the ambit of "small quantity", punishment whereof is prescribed only upto one year, therefore, he may be granted leave to withdraw the instant petition, however, with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court concerned and to make an

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application for bail before the latter, which may be directed to be decided expeditiously.

3. Leave granted.
4. Consequently, the instant petition is **dismissed as withdrawn**, however, with liberty to the petitioner to, within a week from today, surrender before the learned trial Court concerned, and thereupon, if she makes an application before the latter for grant of bail, the latter shall decide the same within two days, but, after affording adequate opportunity of hearing to the opposite party.
