Prayer in the present petition is for directing respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 25.06.2024 of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner however is not in a position to refer any such provision under which the Senior Superintendent of Police can issue a direction or decide a representation. He has been confronted with the provision contained in the erstwhile Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 which provided for alternate remedy not only in the form of moving an application under Section 156 of Cr.P.C. but also in the form of filing a private complaint under Section 200 of Cr.P.C.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present writ petition so as to take recourse to the alternate remedies available to him in accordance with law.



Disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty as aforesaid.

Needless to mention that in the event of moving an appropriate application by the petitioner before the competent Court, such an application/petition shall be decided expeditiously.
