In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioners are that this Court while deciding CWP No.12168 of 2014 had directed that the petitioners be given appointment from the date candidate lower in merit has been appointed along with all consequential benefits except the arrears for the period in question but the respondents have not extended the said benefit to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though the petitioners were given the benefit of appointment retrospectively, they have not been given the benefit of ACP as already granted to the junior employees hence, the respondents were under obligation to fix the pay of the petitioners

equivalent to that being drawn by the juniors of the petitioners and also with regard to the re-designation as Junior Assistant.

Learned counsel for the respondents on instructions from Mr. Rohit Kumar, Clerk, Directorate (Treasury and Accounts), Sector-33A, Chandigarh submits that the claim of the petitioners for the grant of ACP/the grant of benefit extended to the junior employees is under consideration and an appropriation order will be passed granting the same keeping in view the direction given by this Court in CWP No.12168 of 2014 within a period of 8 weeks from today and whatever the benefits the petitioners are found entitled for, the same will be extended including the arrears after their actual appointment as admissible to them.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, the no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of as not pressed.

Ordered accordingly.

Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
