1. Instant writ petition has been filed for issuance of directions to respondents No.4 to 9, to deposit the EPF dues in the account of workers/members of the petitioner organization, in compliance of statutory provision of EPF & Misc. Provision Act, 1952.

2. After being pointed out by counsel for the respondents and on



perusal of the case file, it is noticed that notice of motion was issued way back in the year 2017, and thereafter, none had appeared on behalf of the petitioner – organization on 10.01.2018, 19.07.2018, 18.09.2023 and 15.01.2024.

3. Even today also, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner – organization. Therefore, this Court is left with no other option except to dispose of the writ petition for want of prosecution.

6. **Dismissed for want of prosecution.**
