Prayer in this application is for impleading LR's of the petitioner, namely, Phool Pati, who is stated to have died on 05.07.2021.

The application is allowed. LR's of the petitioner as mentioned in para No.2 of the application are permitted to be impleaded as party to this petition, subject to all just exceptions. Amended memo of parties is taken on record. Office to tag the same at appropriate place in the file.

1. At the outset, learned Senior Advocate appearing on behalf of the respondent-HPGCL submitted that a decision has been taken by the respondent-HPGCL to grant ex-gratia lump sum financial assistance to the petitioner for a sum of Rs.2,50,000/- and since the petitioner has died, the aforesaid amount will be paid to all her five LRs proportionately, who are now on the record.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he will supply the bank account details of all the five LRs of the petitioner to the respondent-HPGCL.
3. Learned Senior Advocate appearing on behalf of the respondent-HPGCL submitted that after the aforesaid bank account details are supplied, then the aforesaid amount will be paid to all the five LRs proportionately in their bank accounts, along with interest @ 6% per annum (simple) from the date when the petitioner made an application i.e. 12.08.2005, within a period of one month from today.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he is satisfied with the aforesaid statement made by the learned Senior Advocate appearing on behalf of the respondent-HPGCL with regard to the aforesaid amount.
5. This Court also appreciates the efforts of Mr. Anurag Jain, learned Amicus Curiae, who had assisted this Court in the present case.
6. Consequently, the aforesaid writ petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
