1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6 who are son, daughters-in-law of petitioner No.1, as the petitioners are being harassed unnecessarily by the private respondents even they are not provided proper food and their day-to-day basic needs/expenses and the petitioners also moved notice dated 21.05.2024 (Annexure P-1) to respondents No.2 and 3 but no action thereon.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have already served a legal notice dated 21.05.2024 (Annexure P-1) upon respondent No.2, however, no action has been taken on the same till date.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

4. Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to decide the legal notice dated 21.05.2024 (Annexure P-1) served by the petitioners in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and also to provide security to the petitioners in case the same is required in the facts and circumstances of the present case.
