NAMIT KUMAR, J.(ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the present writ petition claiming 75% of the salary as subsistence allowance after completion of 06 months of the period of his suspension.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner has already been reinstated in the service and has also retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation and some of his retiral benefits have also been released except gratuity and admissible amount of suspension allowance. He further submits that the petitioner has been acquitted in the criminal case No.CHI/377/2016 vide judgment dated 17.04.2023 passed by the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana.

3. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner shall make a detailed representation to the respondents for claiming his remaining dues and the same shall be considered by the respondents in a time bound manner.

4. If the petitioner files a detailed representation within a period of one month, the same shall be considered and disposed of by the respondents within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of said representation.
5. The petition is disposed of accordingly.
