1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the claim of the petitioner as raised in the present writ petition, has already been approved and has been sent to the District Treasury Officer, Ludhiana for the release of the emoluments.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that appropriate direction be issued to the District Treasury Officer, Ludhiana to release the benefits in a time bound manner as the petitioner has no other source of income to survive.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that efforts will be made by the Administrative Department also to get the benefits released and any direction from this Court will help the Department to get the benefit released to the petitioner at an earlier date.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case where the petitioner has no one to take care of her and is only dependent upon the benefits which has been directed to be released, the District Treasury Officer, Ludhiana is directed to look into the matter and get the benefit released within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order so that the petitioner is able to live dignified life as envisaged under Article 21 of the Constitution of India.

5. In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of in above stated terms.
