1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to reinstate the petitioner in service alongwith all consequential benefits w.e.f. 29.02.2024 with a further prayer to pay the salary of the petitioner from March, 2024 to till date.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner had served a legal notice dated 10.04.2024 (Annexure P-8) to the respondents but the same has not been considered and decided till date. She further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case the aforesaid legal notice dated 10.04.2024 (Annexure P-8) is considered and decided by the respondents in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.
3. Notice of motion.



4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents. She submitted that in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, she has no objection in case time bound direction is issued in this regard.

5. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without calling for reply from the respondents and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice dated 10.04.2024 (Annexure P-8) strictly in accordance with law and within a period of three months from today.
