1. Counsel for the petitioner submits that civil litigation is already going on between the petitioner and respondent No.6 and now respondents No.6 to 12 are extending threats to cause physical harm to the petitioner and in this regard representation dated 26.06.2023 (Annexure P-1) is already given by husband of the petitioner to respondents No.2, 4 & 5 but the concerned authorities failed to take any action in accordance with law against the aforesaid private respondents. It is further submitted that petitioner will be satisfied if necessary direction is given to respondent No.4 to consider and decide representation Annexure P-1 submitted by the petitioner in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Siddharth Attri, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State and on instructions from ASI Gurdeep Singh submits that the civil Court is already seized of the matter regarding land dispute going on



between the private parties. It is further submitted that in case any such representation given by the petitioner is pending, the same will be disposed of by the competent authority in accordance with law at the earliest.

4. In light of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to respondent No.4 to consider and decide representation dated 26.06.2023 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of one month of the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. However, it is made clear that any observation made herein above and the decision taken by the competent authority on the basis of representation/complaint (Annexure P-1) will be having no bearing on the civil litigation pending between the private parties.
