1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the respondents to register an FIR against the accused persons.
2. At the very outset, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has directly approached this Court in violation of the ratio of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Sakiri Vasu Vs. State of U.P. and others, 2008 (1) RCR (Criminal) 392* and by this Court in *Hansa Singh Vs. State of Punjab, CRM-M-18831-2022, decided on 12.05.2022*, wherein it has been held that the Magistrate has been bestowed with all necessary powers and is

well equipped to ensure proper investigation under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. As such, on this ground alone, present petition deserves to be dismissed.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition and seeks liberty to invoke the alternative remedy as available to her, for redressal of the grievance raised in the present petition, in accordance with law.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
