1. By way of present petition, prayer has been made for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents on account of alleged willful non-compliance of order dated 06.03.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-26136-2022.

2. In response, compliance report by way of affidavit of Dr. Kanwaldeep Singh, Senior Medical Officer, Civil Hospital Fatehgarh Sahib on behalf of the respondents has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions, submits that the necessary financial benefits shall be released in favour of the petitioner within a period of three weeks from today.

4. In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed

in the present petition, as such, the same is disposed of. Rule stands discharged.

5. However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
