Learned counsel for the Municipal Corporation, Gurugram (respondent No.3), has placed before us a copy of the Gazette notification dated March 6, 2024, issued by the Urban Local Bodies Department, under Section 3 of the Haryana Management of Civic Amenities and Infrastructure Deficient Municipal Areas (Special Provisions) Act, 2016. Per which, the areas specified in the schedule set out in notification have been declared to be civic amenities and infrastructure deficient areas. Copy of the notification is taken on record as **Mark 'X'**. He submits that nothing substantive survives in the petition as the area in question in the instant petition is also included in the notification (**ibid**).
