1. This is the 1st petition filed by the petitioners under Section
438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in:-

12	10.02.2021	Cyber Crime Police Station, Gurugram	Section 408 read with Section 420 of IPC, 1860 and Section 66 of Information Technology Act, 2000



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2. Demand drafts of Rs.75 lacs have been handed over to the complainant, as has been recorded by this Court vide order dated 28.05.2024 in connected CRM-M-37666-2021 titled as Satej Neelkanth Jamage Vs. State of Haryana and others.
3. Upon instructions from Inspector Savit Kumar, State counsel submits that petitioners have joined the investigation, although, *challan* has not been presented.
4. In view of the above development, without commenting upon the merits of the allegations, present petition is allowed and interim order dated 17.09.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute, subject to the satisfaction of the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
5. It is once again clarified that handing over the drafts of Rs.75 lacs to the complainant would not prejudice the civil proceedings, if any, initiated by the petitioners or their right of defence.
