At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been issued a letter of appointment as Physical Training Instructor (PTI) on 02.01.2023, and joined as such on 03.01.2023. Accordingly, he may be permitted to withdraw the petition with liberty to raise a claim for notional benefits from the date of other selected candidates have been appointed.

2. Learned State counsel contends that in case any such representation is filed by the petitioner within a period of four weeks, the same will be decided by the third respondent/Director, Elementary Education, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of three months.

3. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.

4. Ordered accordingly.
