1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.117 dated 18.06.2024 under Sections 452, 324, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City-1 Abohar, District Fazilka.

2. On 08.07.2024, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, a Coordinate Bench of this Court, had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked him to join investigation:-

“Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and even otherwise, no specific injury is attributed to the petitioner and further alleged injury is found to be simple in nature. He further submits that the petitioner having no criminal antecedents is ready to join investigation with the police.”

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3. Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

4. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 08.07.2024, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of the BNSS/438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
