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HARSH BUNGER, J. (ORAL)

1. Petitioner (Jaspal Singh Aujla) has filed the instant civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent No. 2 to decide the representation (Annexure P-2), submitted by the petitioner.
2. On advance service of copy of petition, learned State counsel appears and submits that respondent No. 2 (Deputy Commissioner, District Fatehgarh Sahib) shall consider and take a decision on the representation (Annexure P-2), submitted by the petitioner.
