1. The present petition has been filed under Section 10 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India against the respondents for willful disobedience and defiance of order dated 30.11.2021 (Annexure P-1), passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Ludhiana.
2. Perusal of the case file shows that the order qua which the contempt is alleged, has been passed by the Civil Court. The said Court is having sufficient power and wide competence to get its own order executed. The petitioner can get the aforesaid order executed or get his grievance remedied by availing an appropriate modality before the Court below.
3. Resultantly, the presnet contempt petition is dismissed.
4. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
