1. Counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that respondents No.3 to 14 attacked the petitioner on 12.05.2024 and with regard to said incident, representation/complaint (Annexure P-4) was given by the petitioner to respondent No.2 which is dated 24.05.2024 but the police authorities failed to take any action against the aforesaid respondents in accordance with law. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that necessary direction be given to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and to take necessary steps in accordance with law against private respondents No.3 to 14 on the basis of representation/complaint (Annexure P-4) in a time bound manner.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Siddharth Attri, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that civil dispute regarding management of Dera is going on between the private parties and civil Court is seized of the matter



as is clear from Annexure P-1. The State counsel further submits that in case, any such representation or complaint lodged by the petitioner is pending, the same will be considered and decided by the competent authority in accordance with law within a given time frame.

4. In light of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to respondents No.2 to look into the matter and decide representation dated 24.05.2024 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of one month of the receipt of certified copy of the present order. However, it is made clear that any observation made herein above and the decision taken by the competent authority on the basis of representation/complaint (Annexure P-4) will be having no bearing on the civil litigation pending between the private parties.
