The instant criminal writ petition has been filed under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to the respondents No. 2 and 3 to give police protection to the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8 and further for directing respondents No. 2 and 3 not to harass the petitioners and family members of petitioner No.2 at the instance of respondent Nos. 4 to 8.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset submits that for their grievance, the petitioners have already submitted a representation (Annexure P-3) to the Senior Superintendent of Police,

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Fazilka, but no action has been taken thereon so far. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioners would be satisfied in case said representation(s) are decided in a time bound manner.

4. Ms. Manjot Kaur, AAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of official respondents.

5. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, official-respondent Nos. 2 to 3 are directed to decide the representation (Annexure P-3) of the petitioners expeditiously but not later than two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
