AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioner Jagdeep Singh filed petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of order dated 20.12.2016, Annexure P-4, passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Barnala in case No. 285/2016, titled “State Versus Balwinder Singh” vide which petitioner has been summoned to face trial under Section 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and for quashing of judgment dated 17.01.2020, Annexure P-6, vide which criminal revision No. 14/2017 filed by petitioner was also dismissed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Barnala.

2. During the pendency of present petition, matter was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre as both parties were ready to effect compromise. Report dated 14.08.2024 has been received from Mediation and Conciliation Centre where all terms and conditions were settled

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between the parties.

3. Today petitioner has handed over demand draft in favour of respondent No. 2 Amar Singh to the tune of ₹3,25,000/- and photocopy of said demand draft is also taken on record. Both petitioner and respondent No. 2 confirmed total compliance of said compromise. Respondent No. 2 has further stated that he has no objection if the impugned order dated 20.12.2016, Annexure P-4, passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Barnala and impugned judgment dated 17.01.2020, Annexure P-6, are quashed.

4. Learned counsel representing State has not disputed the compromise which has been arrived at before Mediation and Conciliation Centre.

5. In view of aforesaid factual position, no purpose would be served by pursuing the trial in FIR No. 30 dated 08.04.2016 under Section 420 of IPC Police Station Tallewal, District Barnala and accordingly, aforesaid order and judgment or any proceedings in aforesaid FIR qua the present petitioner stands quashed.

6. Petition is accordingly, disposed of.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
