Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, he would be satisfied if the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Director, Department of Local Government, Punjab-respondent No.5 to take a decision on the legal notice dated 28.06.2024 (Annexure P-11) issued on behalf of the petitioner.

(2) Learned State counsel, who appears on advance notice, has no objection if the above alternate prayer made on behalf of the petitioner is accepted.

(3) Accordingly, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Director, Department of Local Government, Punjab-respondent No.5 to take a decision on the aforesaid legal notice issued on behalf of the petitioner, by passing speaking order(s) and after affording opportunity of hearing to the



petitioner, preferably within two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

(4) Needless to add that the decision so taken be communicated to the petitioner and if the same is not to the satisfaction of the petitioner, the petitioner would be at liberty to challenge the same, in accordance with law.
